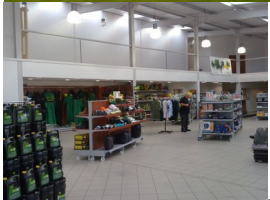

## Rules for Exhibitors

1. All categories are open to residents of the Parishes of the Whittlesey Team Ministry - Coates, Eastrea, Turves, Whittlesey, Pondersbridge and surrounding farms. Additionally category 8 is open to all students who attend schools in the above areas, no matter where they live and category 5 is open to members of the Whittlesey Wine Society, no matter where they live.
2. **Entries, accompanied by entry fee(s), on the enclosed form should be sent to a committee member listed on page 7, no later than 12.00 noon on Thursday 14th July.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee, subject to space being available.
3. The venues open at 8.00am for staging. All exhibits must be staged and the venue clear by 9.00am. Judging starts at 9.00 am. No exhibit or any part thereof may be removed until the prize presentations and draws have been completed (around 4.30pm) After exhibitors have removed their exhibits any items remaining may be sold at an auction immediately thereafter.
4. Points awarded: 1st - 4 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, Very Commendable- 1 point
5. The Judges decision is final. In the event of any dispute arising, notice must be given in writing to Mr L Seaton or Mr M Fairbank, within one hour of the opening of the Show when, should the Judges have retired, the matter will be resolved by the Show Committee. All prizes, including Highly Commended, will be awarded at the Judges discretion.
6. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason they decide, without explanation or discussion.
7. The Committee reserve the right to inspect Exhibitors' gardens.
8. All exhibits must be the property of, grown or produced by, the exhibitor, except in the Floral Arrangement classes. Photographs must be taken by the exhibitor.
9. An Exhibitor may make as many entries in any Class as they wish.
10. The Friends of Holy Trinity will not be responsible for any loss of property or injury sustained to any person visiting or participating in the Show.
11. All trophies won to be returned to the committee by 1 July 2012.
12. **An exhibitor, by entering, agrees that they are bound by these rules.**

Parsley may be used as a dressing. Onions to be tied, dry, sound, clean and true to type, double heads are not acceptable, roots to be trimmed.

- 40 A humorously decorated caked (Judged of appearance, rather than taste)
- 41 A boiled fruit cake (Must use following recipe)
  - 4oz margarine
  - 8oz mixed fruit
  - 1/4 pint water
  - 1 beaten egg
  - 1 tsp mixed spice
  - 4oz sugar
  - 8oz self raising flour
